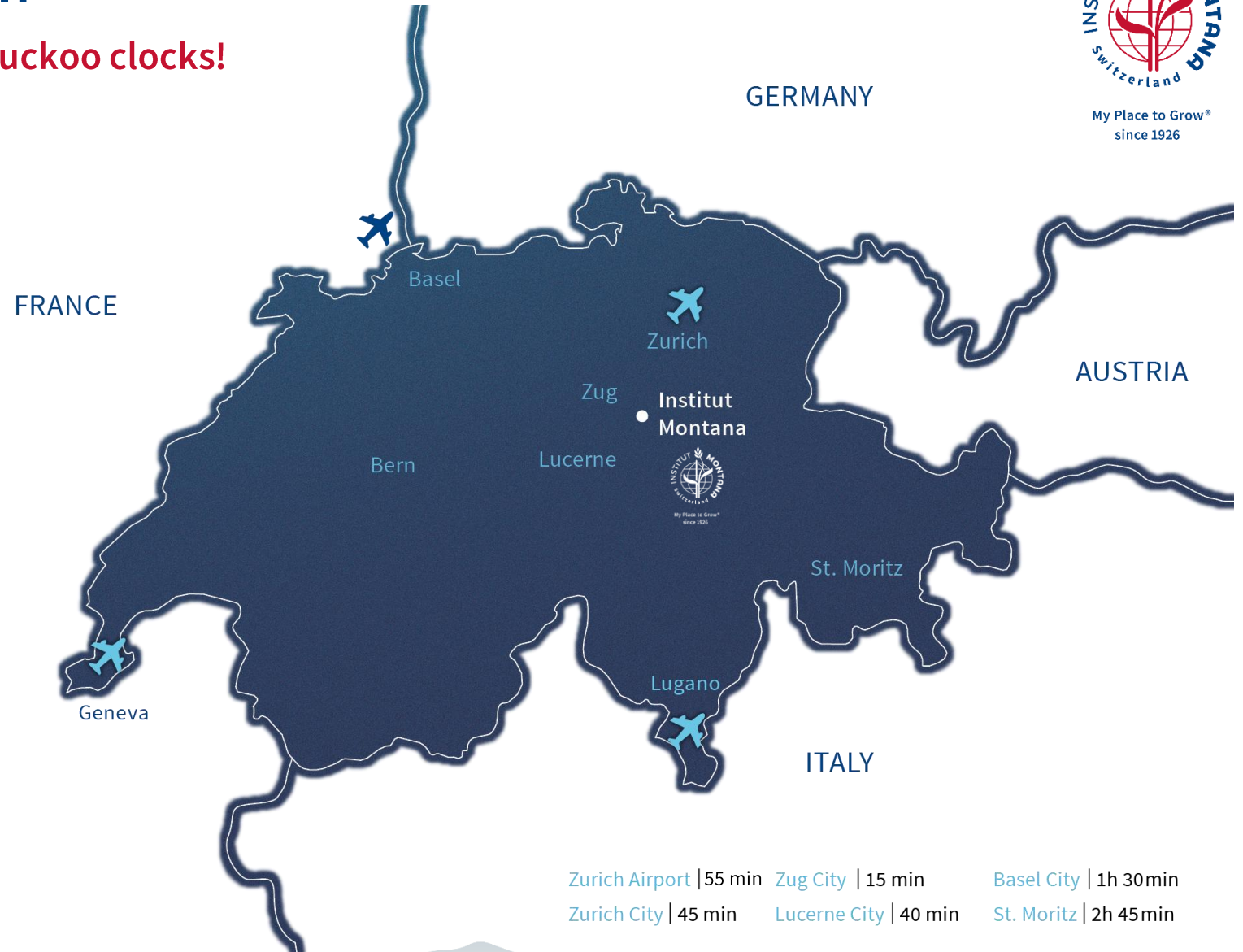


Switzerland: A Place to Learn

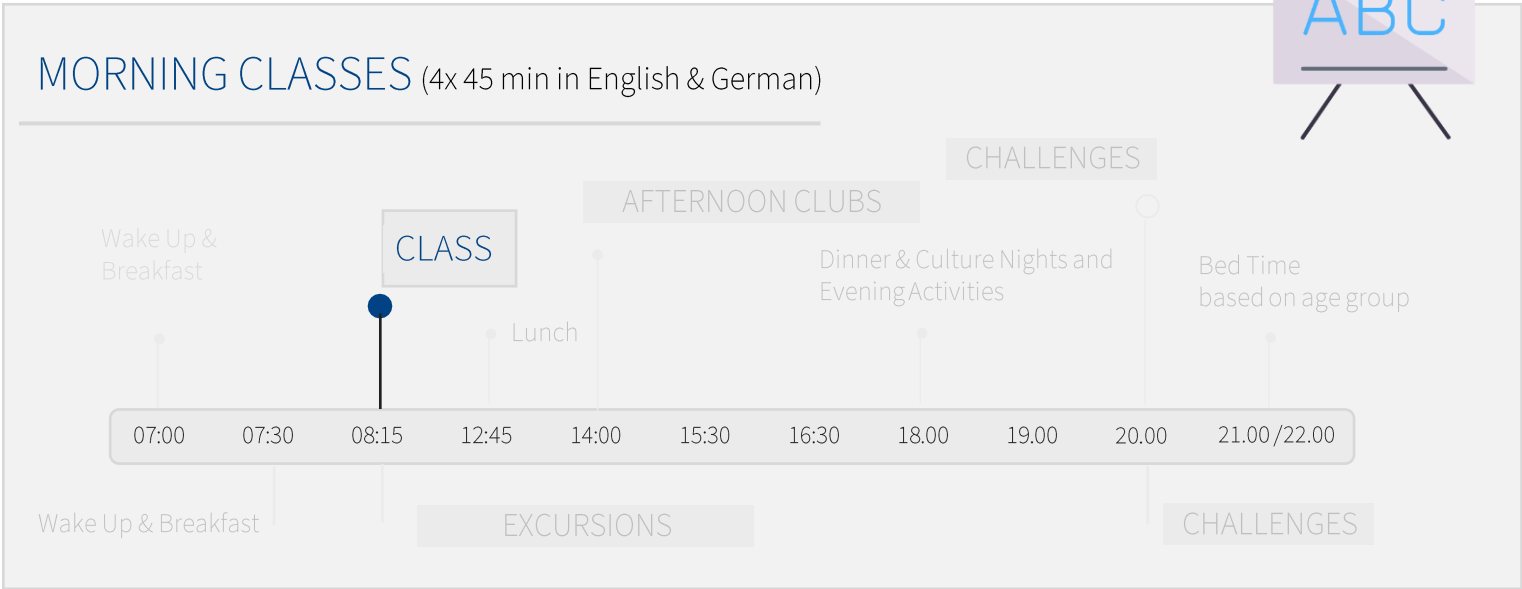

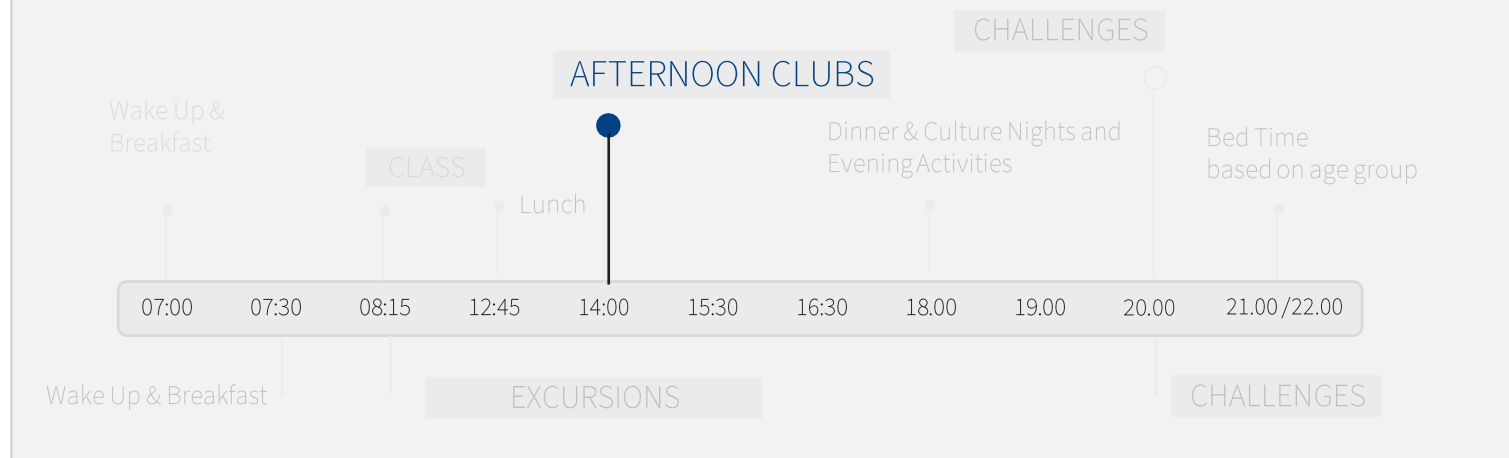

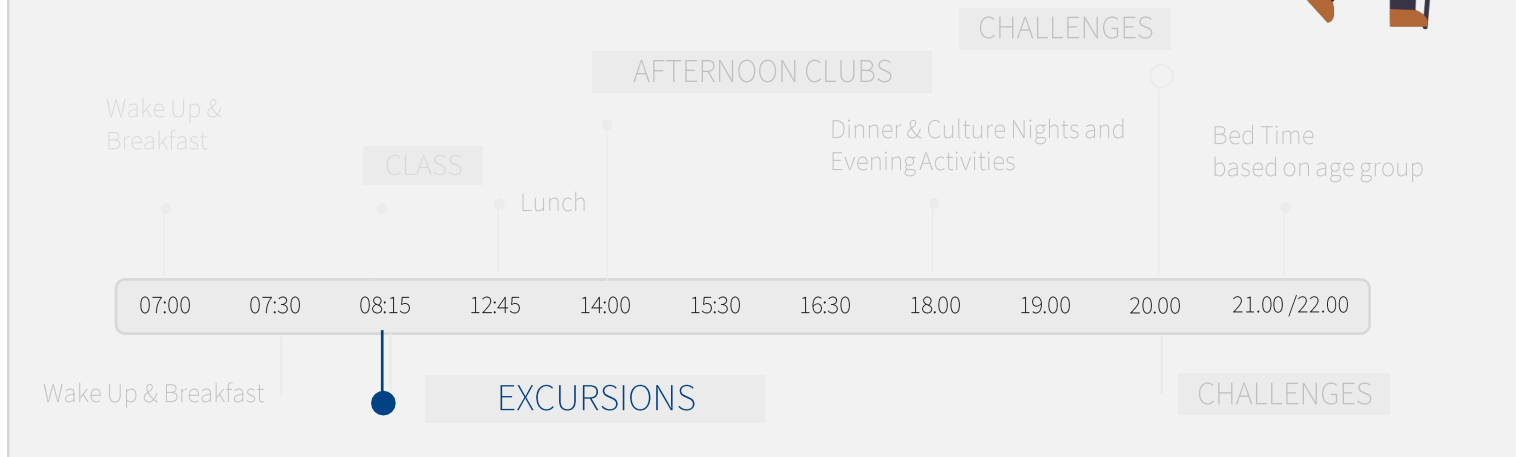

Comfortable double rooms, divided by age and gender. Girls and boys are separated by floor.

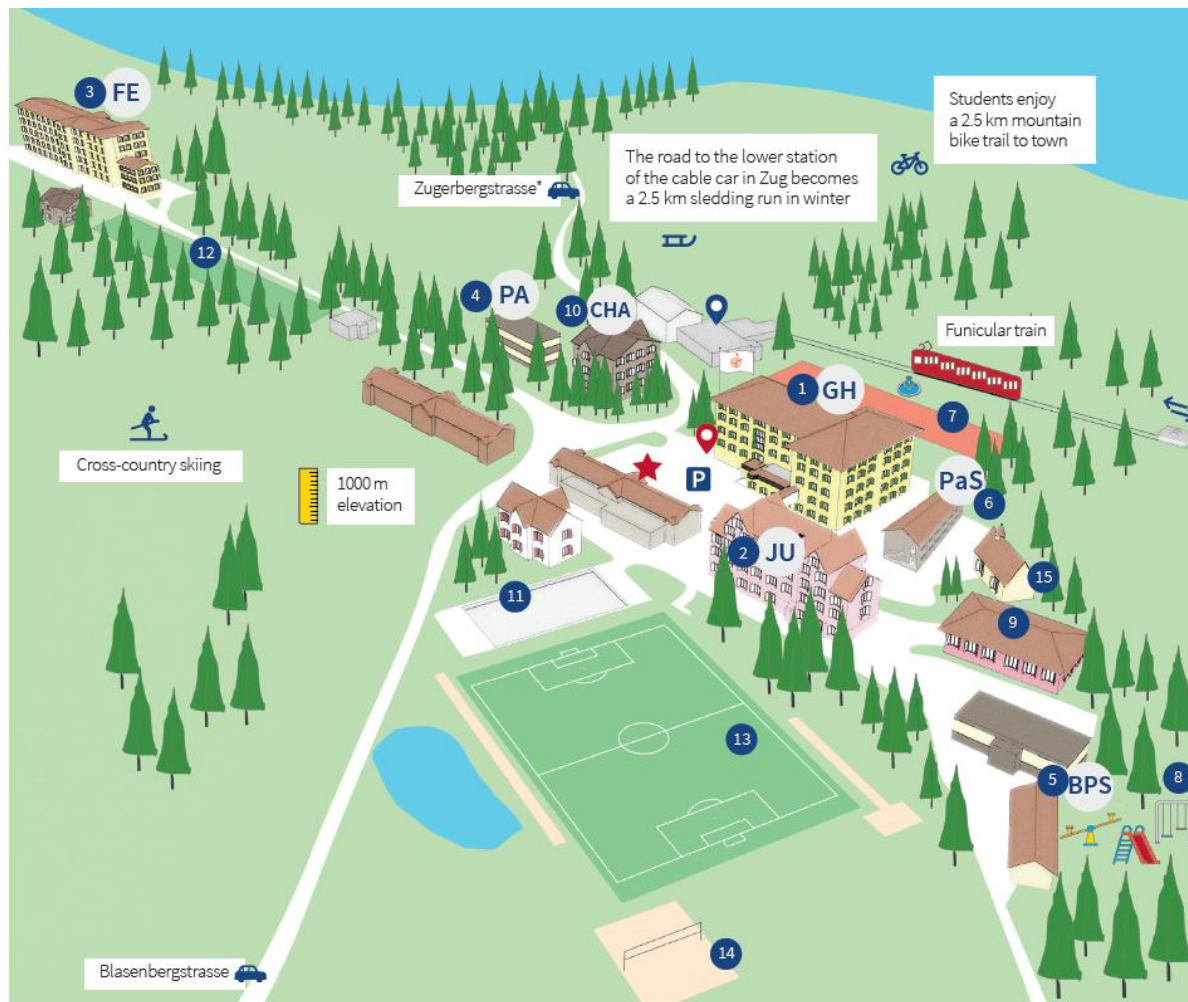
Each floor has two House Parents and other mentors looking after the children around the clock.
